In year 6, we had a visit from Waheeda (who is a Muslim herself). She opened her session by getting us to investigate all about the five pillars of Islam in small groups. It was really interesting and we loved trying on their style of clothing – it must have taken them ages to make as they have tiny gems and sequins on.

We then moved on to be taught about their religious celebrations and she spoke about how Muslims respect our religious celebrations also. They have lots of big banquets and colourful fireworks and artwork to celebrate these.

The process of how Muslims get married was explained to us and we watched videos of how Islam men arrive to their wedding and collect their wife. Henna patterns were painted upon our hands that we had designed ourselves and we learned that this is a ritual that happens called a henna night for the bridge. This, usually, takes place a few days before the marriage is made official.

It was lovely to see what everyone had been getting up to in our end of week assembly and how difference was accepted and respected by everyone here at St Joseph's.
