The children need to choose a book:-

Class	Book
Nursery	Non-fiction book
Reception	Non-fiction book
Year 1	Stories with bears in e.g. Paddington, Old Bear etc
Year 2	Michael Rosen Poems
Year 3	Poetry - any range of poems
Year 4	Non-fiction book about Anglo Saxons
Year 5	Any Michael Morpurgo book (but <u>not</u> Kensukes Kingdom)
Year 6	Poetry - any poems

They need to read the book over the half term holiday. Following this they need to make a model of a character from the story or item from a non-fiction book. However the model can only be a maximum height of 15cm! Any materials can be used for the model - use your imagination - but think small!!

We would like the models and the book in school by Wednesday 4^{th} March, when judging will take place!

There will be 3 main winners from across the school, 1^{st} prize £20 book voucher, 2^{nd} prize £10 book voucher, 3^{rd} prize £5 book voucher.
