Toast - Every Thursday

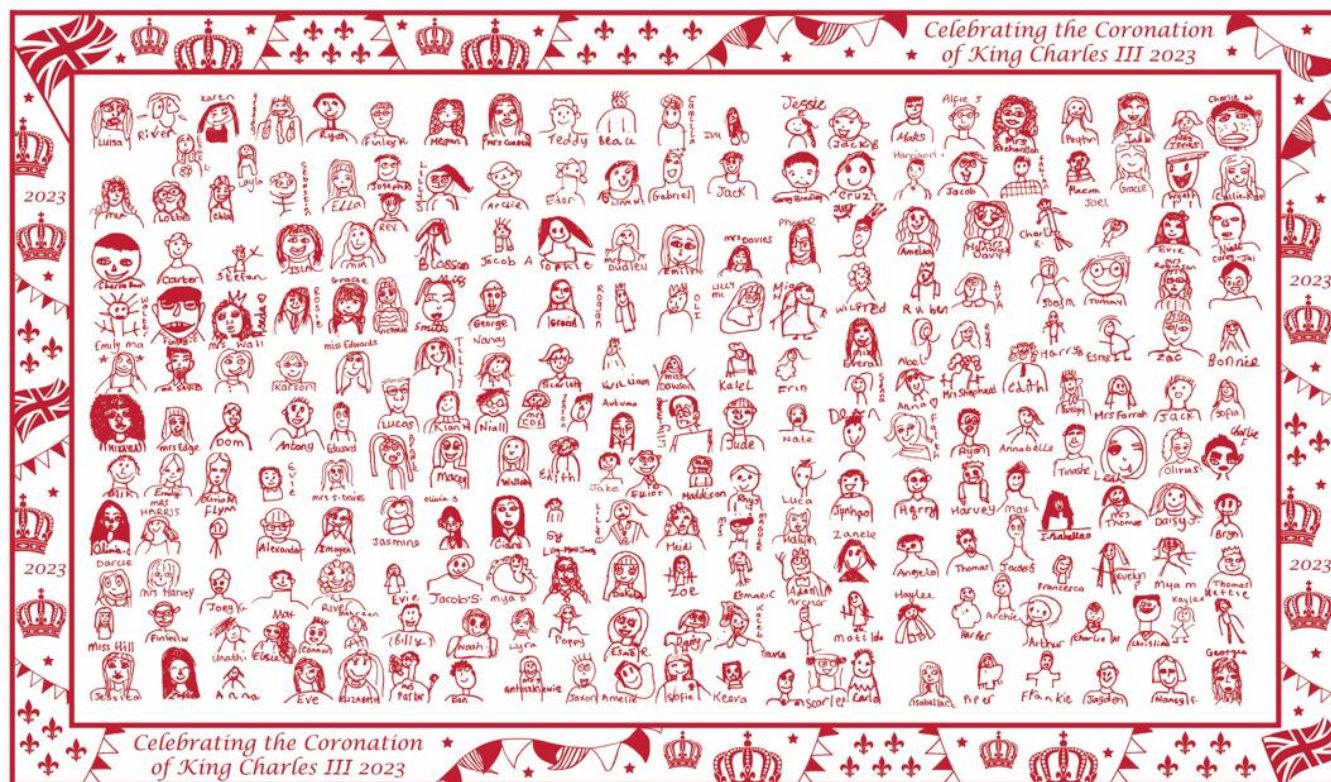
If you would like your child to have toast in school each Thursday morning, please send in £1.40 on Monday 5th June to cover the half term. Please ensure this is in a named envelope.
